Aluminum Lattice
Care and Cleaning Requirements

Permalatt Products, Inc.'s Aluminum lattice adds beauty, distinction, and a lasting value to your home. Your homes exterior requires cleaning and Permalatt Products, Inc. Aluminum Lattice is no different. Over time, with exposure to outdoor elements, your lattice will show signs of normal weathering such as a slight loss of gloss and a slight color change. Cleaning your Aluminum Lattice is the best way to protect your investment by minimizing the effects of weathering as well as removing dirt, grime, and other substances detrimental to the appearance of your lattice.

Some geographic locations offer unique environmental exposure issues that require specific cleaning schedules. To insure your investment lasts a lifetime please adhere to the below cleaning requirements for your Permalatt Products, Inc. Aluminum Lattice. Disregarding the following cleaning requirements will void the Permalatt Products, Inc. warranty.

- For Lattice located within 1,500 feet of a body of salt or brackish water or in areas influenced by other airborne contaminants cleaning is required every three months.
- For Lattice located more than 1,500 feet from a body of salt or brackish water or in areas influenced by other airborne contaminants cleaning is required every six months.

Hand Washing Instructions

- Wet the Permalatt Products, Inc. Aluminum Lattice with a garden hose.
- Hand wash all surfaces with a sponge or soft cloth using a mild detergent (see recommendations below).
- For best results start at the top of the lattice and work downward.
- Thoroughly rinse the lattice to remove all residues. Water with a high solids or mineral content may leave spots – for areas with these issues we recommend drying the fence or railing with a soft white cloth.

Pressure Washing Instructions

- A detergent additive is suggested (see recommendations below).
- Do not exceed 1,000 PSI and keep nozzle tip at least 18" from your lattice.
- Wash all exposed surfaces.
- Rinse thoroughly, if detergent is added to pressure washer. In areas where water may have a high solids or mineral content we recommend drying with a soft white cloth to avoid spots.

Detergent Requirements

General purpose household soaps and detergents are acceptable. Do not use any type of soap or detergent that recommends gloves or respirators for personal protection. Do not use a soap or detergent that could damage a painted finish.
